Description of the information:

The ACT Corrective Services *Code Red (Fire) Operating Procedure 2020* provides directions to staff in relation to a fire in a correctional centre.

Grounds for the decision:

Public release of the ACT Corrective Services *Code Red (Fire) Operating Procedure 2020* was deemed to be contrary to the public interest. The specific criteria prompting exemption from public release is Schedule 1.14 of the *Freedom of Information Act 2016*.

- Schedule 1.14 Law Enforcement or Public Safety Information
 - *(i) prejudice a system or procedure for the protection of people, property or the environment.*
