# ACT VICTIMS REGISTER

## What is the ACT Victims Register?

ACT Corrective Services maintains the ACT Victims Register. This register records the names and contact details of victims who have asked to be registered in order to receive information about an adult offender who is in prison or under the supervision of ACT Corrective Services.

Information kept on the ACT Victims Register is used only for the purpose of contacting and informing a registered victim about a sentenced offender. Information held on the register is confidential and will not be released to others. The ACT Victims Register is strictly controlled and access to it is limited to a small number of authorised staff.

Registration on the ACT Victims Register will ensure that you are invited to make a written submission to the Sentence Administration Board of the ACT if the offender for whom you are registered is being considered for release on parole or licence.

## Who can be placed on the ACT Victims Register?

You can request placement on the ACT Victims Register if:

- you have suffered physical injury, mental injury or emotional suffering (including grief), pregnancy, economic loss or a substantial impairment of rights accorded by law as a result of a criminal act committed against you by an adult offender, or
- you were financially or psychologically dependant on a person immediately before that person died as a direct result of a criminal act committed against them, or
- you have parental responsibility of a person less than 15 years of age who was the victim of a criminal act.

## What information can a registered victim receive?

If you are a registered victim of an offender who is serving a term of imprisonment, you may be informed of the following:

- the length of the sentence, the offender's parole eligibility date and earliest release date;
- the correctional centre where the offender is detained and any transfer of the offender to another correctional facility;
- any change in the offender's security classification which may result in the offender being eligible for unescorted leave;
- any unescorted leave given to the offender;
- the death, escape of or any other exceptional event relating to the offender.

If you are a registered victim of an offender who is serving a sentence by way of periodic detention or a community based order, you may, at the discretion of ACT Corrective Services, be informed of the following:

- the duration of the offender's order;
- information about the place and time the offender may be required to report for periodic detention or community service work;
- any non-association order or place restriction order that relates to you;
- the cancellation or variation of the offender's order

## How do I register?

Upon receipt of your completed registration form, you will be provided with information about the offender's sentence and, from then on, be informed of any significant change to the offender's status.
