



COMMISSIONER INSTRUCTION 07/2022

Change to Executive Position Titles

Position titles for several executives and senior staff members have changed from June 2022. This Commissioner Instruction provides guidance to staff on interpreting titles in policy documents.

As of June 2022, the Deputy Commissioner Custodial Operations position has ceased, and in the interim, the functions of that previous role have been absorbed into the responsibilities of the General Manager AMC, which has an added alternative name of the Assistant Commissioner Custodial Operations.

Significant work is underway to review delegations and responsibilities for all management and supervisor roles at the AMC. The AMC senior management will engage AMC staff in discussions regarding this review shortly.

As of June 2022, the new title for the Assistant Commissioner Community Corrections is now Assistant Commissioner Service Improvement and Community Operations.

Where a previous position title is referred to in a policy, operating procedure or community instruction, these responsibilities have now been assumed by the roles in the following table:
